

TWEED CYCLEWAY CYCLE ROUTE

What is it?

95-mile linear route from Biggar to Berwick-upon-Tweed through the heart of the Scottish Borders following the course of the River Tweed.

Why do it?

Excellent views of the countryside surrounding the Tweed. Passes through picturesque Border towns, fine hill and forest backdrops, with lots of interesting visitor attractions along the way.

Great places to stay, high quality restaurant and coffee stops en-route.

How tough?

Moderate – a few steep sections.

The vast majority of the route is on quiet roads. The route is usually tackled in an easterly direction and takes 3-5 days to complete.

Getting There

The nearest railway station to Biggar is Carstairs Junction (approx 10 miles from Biggar). The route ends at Berwick-upon-Tweed where there is also a train station.

Where to stay?

The route can be conveniently split into four 20-30 mile sections, starting at Biggar, with overnight stops in Peebles, Melrose, Kelso/Coldstream and finishing in Berwick.

Alternatively cyclists could take the route as two 50-mile sections starting in Biggar with an overnight stop in Melrose and ending in Berwick. All suggested accommodation below is Cyclists Welcome accredited which means they provide additional facilities for visitors touring Scotland by bicycle, such as secure bike storage, clothes-drying facilities and flexible eating arrangements to accommodate unpredictable arrival times.

What to see? A few suggestions on things to see en-route:

TRAQUAIR HOUSE, Innerleithen, nr Peebles

Oldest continuously occupied house in the British Isles. Also the site of a brewery, craft workshops and tearoom. Open April – November Admission charged www.traquair.co.uk

ABBOTSFORD HOUSE, nr Melrose

Historic home of Sir Walter Scott, one of Scotland's most important literary figures. Tearoom and gift shop on-site.

Open mid March – end October

Admission charged

KELSO ABBEY

Kelso Abbey was founded during the reign of King David I (1124-1153). At one time the grandest of the Border Abbeys, its location meant it saw many English armies pass by over the centuries. Regular raids by the English (particularly in the 1540s under Henry VIII) have led to little of this magnificent building surviving.

Admission free - Open all year

MELROSE ABBEY

Melrose Abbey is a magnificent ruin on a grand scale with lavishly decorated masonry including the bagpipe-playing Melrose pig. The Abbey is thought to be the burial place of Robert the Bruce's heart, marked with a commemorative carved stone plaque within the grounds. Visitors can also visit a small museum housing a display of artifacts found within the abbey.

Admission charged - Open all year

FLOORS CASTLE

Built in 1721, Floors Castle is the ancestral home of the Duke of Roxburghe and still inhabited by the current Duke and his family. There is an interesting garden centre in the

grounds which is open all year, and two tearooms:

- The Terrace Café (nr garden centre) open all year
- The Courtyard Restaurant (open during the tourist season)

Open Easter - October Admission charged for the Castle

Peebles, Melrose and Kelso also have a selection of interesting shops and Melrose has a small theatre, The Wynd (check-out the programme at www. thewyndmelrose.com).

SMAILHOLM TOWER

Smailholm Tower is one of the most evocative sights in the Border country. Its stark form is a dominant feature in the rolling landscape of the Tweed valley. Smailholm's story takes us from the 15th century to just beyond the Union between Scotland and England in 1707. The lonely tower is associated with two notable Border families – first the Pringles (Hoppringles) up to 1645; thereafter the Scotts of Harden, ancestors of Sir Walter Scott.

Admission charged – open all year

ROBERT SMAIL'S WORKSHOP, INNERLEITHEN

A unique example of our industrial heritage in the form of a fully operational Victorian Letterpress Printing Works in the Borders town of Innerleithen.

Admission charged - open April to October. www.nts.orq.uk

DAWYCK BOTANIC GARDEN, NR PEEBLES

Renowned for its seasonal displays, an abundance of exotic and native plants provides a breathtaking backdrop of colour throughout the year. Enjoy the award-winning visitor centre.

BOWHILL HOUSE AND COUNTRY ESTATE, NEAR SELKIRK

For more than seven centuries the Scotts of Buccleuch have been part of Scottish Borders history and their principal house, Bowhill is today home to the Duke and Duchess of Buccleuch and Queensberry. Bowhill sits at the heart of an energetic country estate amidst the magical scenery of the Yarrow and Ettrick valleys. Mountain biking, walks and wildlife are all on offer alongside a gift shop and tea room.

Admission charged. House open July-August, the Estate has various opening times from April-August, please check. www.bowhill.org


FARMERS MARKETS

Great places to pick up goodies for a packed lunch or foodie gifts to take home.


