Shuttle bus for Scott's View

A free shuttle bus will operate between Earlston, and Dryburgh Abbey Hotel on Sunday 3 September from 11.30am to 3.50pm for spectators who wish to view the race at the SKODA King of the Mountains location at Scott's View. The race is estimated to pass there at around 2.30pm.

Free parking will be available in the grounds of Dryburgh Abbey Hotel and on street in Earlston. The shuttle bus will pick up from Earlston bus stance and Dryburgh Abbey Hotel and drop spectators at Scott's View.

Parking will be prohibited and strictly enforced over a section of the route on the B6356 to keep the race route clear.
